JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA AND THE KINGDOM OF BAHRAIN

The Government of the Federated States of Micronesia and the Government of the Kingdom of Bahrain,

Guided by their mutual willingness to develop friendly, peaceful and cooperative relations between the two countries in the political, economic, trade, cultural and other fields of mutual interests;

Respecting the principles of equality among States, national sovereignty, independence, territorial integrity and non-interference in the internal affairs of other States;

Convinced that the establishment of diplomatic relations corresponds to the interest of both States and will further strengthen international peace and security,

Have agreed to establish diplomatic relations in accordance with the principles and purposes of the United Nations Charter, the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18th April 1961 as of the date of signature of this Joint Communiqué.

The Government of the Federated States of Micronesia and the Government of the Kingdom of Bahrain express their assurances that the establishment of diplomatic relations corresponds to the national interests of both countries and will consolidate international peace and cooperation.

In witness thereof, the undersigned representatives, duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed this Joint Communiqué, in New York on 21 September 2022, in duplicate, each in Arabic and English languages, both texts being equally authentic. In case of divergence in interpretation, the English text shall prevail.
