



JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS

BETWEEN THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA AND BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

The Federated States of Micronesia and Bosnia and Herzegovina:

Desirous of promoting mutual understanding and strengthening friendship and cooperation between the two countries;

Guided by the principles and purposes enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations and the principles of international law, particularly the respect and promotion of international peace and security, equality among States, respect for national sovereignty and territorial integrity, independence, international treaties, and noninterference in internal affairs of States;

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations with effect from the date of the signature of this Joint Communiqué in accordance with the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961, the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations of 24 April 1963, and the principles enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations.

In witness whereof, the undersigned, being duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed this Joint Communiqué in two originals in the English language.
